The Double Header Cooking For Scholarships BBQ Cook-Off contest is hosted by the District 2-S4 Lions Charities/ Brazosport Breakfast Lions Club. The contest will be held at the Brazos Mall on November 17th thru November 19th at 100 TX-332 West, next to JC Penney's in Lake Jackson, Texas 77566.

Contest Rules are as follows:

- Entries must be received by November 17, 2023.

- 2. All sites must submit an original entry form with payment. Entry fees are non-refundable and must accompany entry form. Entry Fee for November 18th is \$100 per team. Entry fee for November 19th is \$100 per team.
- 3. Check-in and set-up will begin at 9:00am on Friday, November 17th. **No electricity or water is provided** so you need to have your own generator.
 - A cooks meeting will be held Friday, November 17th at 5:00pm at the check-in location.
- 4. No pre-seasoned or pre-cooked meats will be allowed. For all cooking requirements check CBA website for complete rules. rules.pdf (cbabbq.com)

 Fach mit must be a guinged with at least a 10lb. Multipurpose and for ABC fire extinguisher.
 - Each pit must be equipped with at least a 10lb. Multipurpose and/or ABC fire extinguisher.
- The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and visitors. Absolutely no firearms or
 explosives will be allowed. Amplification equipment should be used in moderation and not to interfere with
 other teams. ALL SUCH EQUIPMENT WILL BE TURNED OFF BY MIDNIGHT.

Live Bands are not allowed in the BBQ area.

Abuse of the rules will result in disqualification and will be asked to leave the BBQ grounds.

- 6. The Brazosport Breakfast Lions will not be responsible for theft or damage to equipment, supplies or personal belongings while participating in this event.
- 7. The decisions of the BBQ Cook-Off Chairperson and judges are final.
- 8. All spaces will be approximately 30' x 30'. All teams must supply some form of grease catch pan with absorbent for each pit.
- 9. Cash awards will be awarded for 1st through 6th Place and recognition will be given for 7th through 10th place for Brisket, Pork, Ribs and Chicken. Cash awards will be given for 1st through 3rd for Jackpot.

- 10. Each team will supply their own meats.
- 11. Each team will be responsible for having their contest meat at the judging station, in provided containers at the designated time. Contest meat entries received after the designated time (determined by the Official Clock) will not be accepted for judging.
- 12. Contest Chairman reserves the right to amend or make additional regulations as situations may warrant.
